BACTEX® CF is a liquid cationic sanitiser registered by the APVMA for the treatment of mould and bacteria on farming equipment. The in-built detergent system incorporated in BACTEX® CF is highly effective at removing soil and other contamination from vehicles and equipment. BACTEX® CF can now be used to control Panama Disease at a concentration of 10mL/L in 5 minutes.

BACTEX® CF is safe for use on most surfaces including all metal types, stainless steel, plastics and glass. BACTEX® CF should be diluted 10mL/Litre of water (1:100). It is recommended to use a high pressure washer to rinse the surface to remove all soil and detergent residue. Wash down areas should:

- Be readily accessible and located between the driveway and farm roads.
- Be well away from crops.
- Have access to power and water.
- Have a packed gravel or sealed concrete or bitumen surface.
- Not drain into a waterway or crop.
- Have a sump or collection area for easy inspection.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Remove all animals and birds before use. Empty all water and feed containers and seal sheds. Dilute BACTEX® CF Sanitiser 1:150 (10mL per 1.5 Litre) with clean, cold water.

Allow solution to contact surfaces for at least 10 minutes and proceed with normal wash out procedure. For Panama Disease, dilute BACTEX® CF 1:100 (10mL per 1 Litre) with clean, cold water. Allow solution to contact surfaces for at least 5 minutes.
